

HOW MIGHT THIS CHANGE AFFECT THE FUTURE?

Hey, we all have assumptions about the future, it's cool, but, **the future isn't written in stone**. Let's practice broader thinking with a Futures Wheel. It's a lot cheaper using a piece of paper (or ten) than to roll out a plan without considering positive opportunities or unintended consequences.

1. First, identify what is changing. Label it in **NAME THE CHANGE**.
2. Then consider first, second and third-order consequences of this change under each theme in **STEEP** Science, Technology, Environment, Economy, Policy, and Values.
3. Identify your assumptions by asking **What if...?** and **So what...?** and **Now what?**

When you are finished you will have a larger perspective on the impact of your decision.
